

GOTCHA AGAIN!

You do not need to memorize every line, comma, and verse in the Bible.

What you do need is to be in the Word daily — so that when you need a verse, the Holy Spirit can bring it to mind, and you can stand confident because you carry the incorruptible Word of God in your heart.

1 Peter 1:23 — *“Since you have been born again... through the living and abiding word of God.”*

10 VERSES WORTH KNOWING FOR EVANGELISM CONVERSATIONS

01 1 John 1:6

“If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.”

- Use it when someone claims to know God or be a good Christian but their life clearly doesn't match it — gently, not as a gotcha.

02 Romans 6:1–2

“What shall we say then? Are we to continue in sin that grace may abound? By no means!”

- Use it when someone assumes grace means sin doesn't matter — grace isn't a license, it's a rescue.

03 Ephesians 2:8–9

“For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works.”

- Use it to explain that salvation isn't earned by being good enough — it's received as a gift.

04 Galatians 2:21

“For if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.”

- Use it when someone says being a good person is enough — if that worked, the cross wouldn't have been necessary.

05 Revelation 21:8

"...and all liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death."

- Use it as a sobering reminder that sin has real, eternal weight — said with love, not as a threat.

06 John 3:3

"Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

- Use it to explain that being religious or moral isn't the same as actually being saved — something has to change from the inside.

07 Isaiah 53:5–6

"But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities... and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all."

- Use it to show Jesus was prophesied centuries in advance — this isn't a story written after the fact.

08 Romans 3:23

"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

- Use it as the foundation — nobody is exempt, so the conversation starts on level ground, not "me vs. you."

09 Romans 10:9–10

"If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

- Use it when someone's ready to respond — this is the clearest, simplest picture of what it actually takes.

10 John 14:6

"Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'"

- Use it when someone says all religions lead to the same place — Jesus Himself made an exclusive claim, and it's worth sitting with.
